The body text for the abstract should be in Times New Roman, point 11., single line spacing.

Please start a new paragraph with one line spacing. Do not indent any paragraph. All paragraphs must be fully justified.

Authors may include tables or one small black & white figure of good resolution along with the caption. References (up to 4) can be included at the end of text. **All papers must be written in English.**
